
VETESSENTIALS: AN INTRODUCTION TO ANIMAL CARE

Learning Objectives

Upon completion of this program the successful student will have reliably demonstrated the ability to: describe the roles of veterinary team

members and clinic types, perform basic reception duties using veterinary software, and

identify key anatomy and physiology of small animals. Students will recognize common dog and cat breeds, apply safe animal handling and restraint techniques, and use veterinary terminology in context. They will demonstrate core animal care practices, understand common diseases and the importance of vaccines and wellness exams, and explain animal welfare principles including the Five Freedoms. Additionally, students will identify basic surgical tools and procedures, apply sterile practices, and compare nutritional needs of pets across life stages.
