Enrollment requirements

Students must be in Grade 11 or 12

Common Curriculum throughout each unit

- Learn common terminology used in health care settings.
- Build therapeutic relationships within professional practice standards.
- Understand scope of practice and interprofessional health care teams.
- Develop cultural sensitivity and inclusive practices.
- Identify labour market needs, job opportunities in the local area and how to prepare and apply to college programs.
