Enrollment requirements

Students in Grade 10, 11 or 12

- Explore and research Socio-Economic parameters of the following trade related careers. Carpenter, Electrician, Plumber, Sheet Metal worker.
- Develop and Demonstrate motor skills required Specifically for the fore mentioned Careers.
- Develop Interpersonal skills in relation to individual and group work activities.
- Understand and apply both Imperial and Metric measuring Systems in accordance to industry standards.
- Understand the Apprenticeship System and the educational requirements in order to obtain certification.
- Understand the role of the Skilled Trades BC.
- Understand and demonstrate various mathematical skills related to specified Trades.
- Develop and implement safe working habits.
- Explore the role of Work Safe BC and the regulations that guide safe work practices.
- Develop a good understanding of specified Trades related tools and equipment.
- Develop a basic understanding of Reading and interpreting information on Blue Prints and Shop Drawings.
